Re: Sixth Form Enrolment September 2024

Please find enclosed the information which you will require in preparation for Sixth Form enrolment over the summer holidays. GCSE results day will be on **Thursday 22nd August 2024 from 9 am** at school.

After students receive their GCSE results, **all students <u>must</u>** complete the following Sixth Form Enrolment Form: <u>https://forms.gle/jJkrZ9ernfvNHyX7A</u>

The Enrolment Form will open for completion on **Thursday 22nd August at 10 am**, and then close on **Tuesday 27th August at 10 am**. Failure to meet this deadline may lead to students missing a place on certain courses. **Students must only complete the enrolment form if they have met our school and subject minimum entry requirements, a minimum of 5 A*-C GCSEs.** Please can parents/carers check students' GCSE grades before submitting their enrolment form.

It is essential that the Enrolment Form is completed correctly. Students should only select the number of subjects they wish to study and select '**No Subject**' for the pathways where they have no intention to pursue a subject. Students do not need to select a subject in each pathway. **Advanced Skills will then be added to their timetable in a free pathway.** As highlighted in previous communications, please remember that all choices are subject to Head of Department approval and appropriate pupil numbers on courses.

Year 12 will start their Sixth Form journey on **Friday 6th September 2024** with an Induction Day, where important information will be shared regarding the first week of teaching. The day will commence at 8:50 am in form rooms, before moving to the Main Hall for an assembly with Mrs Burke and myself, followed by a talk from Mrs Davies (Deputy Head of Sixth Form), MIND and Mrs Edwards to support a positive mental mindset and how to manage the work / life balance of Sixth Form life.

Form tutor information will be displayed in the Sixth Form common room from 8:30 am on **Friday 6th September**. From Monday 9th September, most lessons will begin from Lesson 1 at 9 am, providing that individual classes do not contain any students from our collaboration schools. All essential information about this matter and key messages across the academic year will be shared via Google Classroom, so it is essential that all students join the following 'Year 12 – 2024-2025' Google Classroom to keep up to date: ifctvkn
